

Cannon sets Taos forum Sept. 20

Cannon Air Force Base has announced its schedule for public comment forums throughout Northern New Mexico and southern Colorado to discuss its recently released draft environmental assessment. The forum in Taos will be held Tuesday (Sept. 20), 6-9 p.m. at the Kachina Lodge.

Cannon released its draft with a finding of “no significant impact” last week for the Air Force’s proposed low-altitude training exercises. The process now goes into a second 60-day public comment period, the results of which Cannon says will be “reflected” in the assessment’s final draft. The other forums, also 6-9 p.m., are:

SEPT. 22: Santa Fe Community College, Santa Fe;

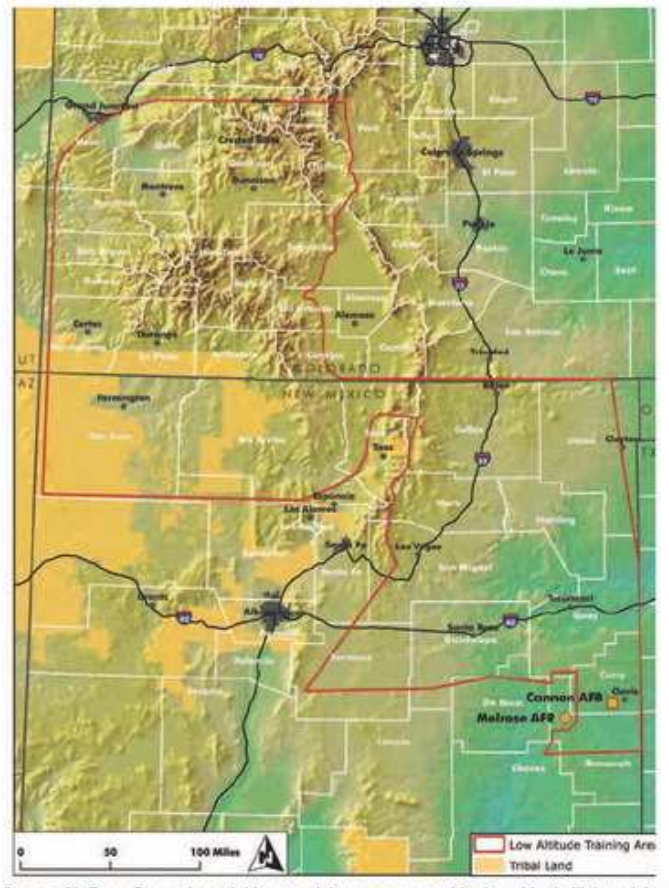
OCT. 3: Alamosa Family Recreational Center, Alamosa, Colo.;
