

Town seeks applicants for planning and Zoning Commission

The town of Taos is soliciting letters of interest from those who would like to sit on the Planning and Zoning Commission.

The seven-member board meets at the Taos Town Council Chambers on Civic Plaza Drive at 5:30 p.m. on the first Wednesday of each month. Planning Director Bill Morris said one seat is currently open. According to town code, five members must be residents of the town, while two appointees may be at-large.

The commission holds public hearings, reviews and makes decisions and recommendations to the Town Council regarding subdivision applications, variances, proposed annexations, town zoning and the town comprehensive plan, among other topics.

Appointments to the commission are made by the mayor and ratified by the Town Council.
