## Architect named to town planning panel

Local architect Doug Patterson is the newest member of the town of Taos Planning and Zoning Commission.

Patterson is a principal of the local Living Designs Group (LDG), which serves as the architectural, planning and engineering consultants for the Taos School District.

“We recently completed a joint project in conjunction with the school district along Town Hall Drive and the mayor and council had the opportunity to see Doug in action as the coordinator of this project”, said Mayor Dan Barrone in a press release. “We are reaching out to our partners in the community to coordinate our efforts and increase cooperation ... and are pleased to now have Doug join this very talented and experienced group of citizen volunteers who are guiding the future growth of our community.”

Patterson previously served several years on the Town Planning and Zoning Commission. When the members of the current Planning and Zoning Commission and Historic Preservation Commission were polled by the town manager as to who they might want the town to consider for the recent opening they were unanimous in their recommendation of Patterson.
