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Sign code OK'd

The Taos Town Council approved Tuesday (Dec. 8) a major revision of the sign code that dictates how businesses can advertise themselves in front of their buildings.

The code, which will undergo final revisions after suggestions from councilors, defines the acceptable size, construction, appearance and placement of all commercial signs within town limits, and require annual licensing, oversight, record keeping and enforcement of those structures.

The old code has been in force since the 1970s and has undergone numerous additions and revisions. This latest version rewrites the entire code but gives existing businesses five years to comply, unless signs are altered or ownership changes.
